Proclamation

Whereas: EXPOSURE TO THE ARTS ALLOWS CHILDREN TO EXPRESS THEIR CREATIVITY AND SHARE ASPECTS OF THEIR CULTURE AND HISTORY WITH THE WORLD; AND

WHEREAS: THE ACTORS THEATER WORKSHOP OF NEW YORK IS A PIONEERING ARTS INSTITUTION THAT HAS OFFERED YOUNG PEOPLE LIVING IN TEMPORARY HOUSING A CHANCE TO SHINE AND DEVELOP THEIR ARTISTIC TALENTS; AND


WHEREAS: YOUNG PEOPLE ENROLLED IN THE THEATER'S PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN LIVING IN TEMPORARY HOUSING BROADEN THEIR HORIZONS WHILE NURTURING THEIR GIFTS AS PERFORMERS AND VISUAL ARTISTS; AND
